#	Group Recommendations, Concerns and Questions
1	Safety- Will there be enough users/activity on the Westside trail?
2	Low income residents being forced out and safety for Seniors
3	Consultants/presenters are from out of town or they don't use appropriate examples. Present ideas or examples that change the character of the neighborhoods
4	Lighting, bicycle & pedestrian safety. Clean up for pet/other waster
5	Opportunities for multigenerational playgrounds & fitness.
6	Clarify signage
7	More directional signage pointing to trails/Beltline
8	Keeping integrity of neighborhoods (mom/pop businesses, middle/low income serving businesses). Little five points is an example
9	Provide temporary access or trail on SE Beltline once purchased/before construction
10	Not enough places to eat, safe places to play
11	No trashcans, no restrooms
12	Signs say no motorized vehicles, but don't make clear that wheelchairs are acceptable
13	Need more police presence
14	Is there a historic preservation code or practice in place to preserve homes/neighborhoods?
15	Where is the Westside Trail, how do all the trails connect, and where do they go?
