Westside Study Group – Resident Round Table

1	Encourage pocket parks (Working with CDHR's)
2	Expand urban farms to produce food for sale
3	Open up temporary hiking trails
4	Encourage trail lighting to be sustainable
5	Outdoor education centers (Art + Architecture)
6	Consider Wind Farms
7	Tiny House demonstration + Zero energy house demonstrations
8	Ensure safety is paramount
9	Incentives for housing affordability
10	Restrooms and water fountains close to trail, closer than every ¼ mile
11	Go to NPU's 3-4 times a year
12	Harvest Rainwater (Possibly from adjacent property's)
13	Way finding signs to get to corridor
14	Encourage existing businesses to be better stewards of their land and have better quality business
15	Market the Atlanta Beltline as "What's in it for me?" by segment or trail
16	Ensuring good access to Murphy Xing (Crossing)
17	Maintain Westside Trail + West end trail along "Warehouse Row"
18	Look at the other CDP suggestions
19	Promote High Density developments with less parking, add charging stations, and bike racks
20	Once the Southside Trail corridor is acquired , create a temporary hiking path
21	Diversity of housing options (race, income, etc.)
22	Consider Segway's + solar – powered carts
23	Better info destination – Signs in parks, More outreach to the neighbors, churches, Georgia stand-up
24	Trail to south DeKalb
25	Fill in gaps within the Stone Mountain trail
